BRONZE-AGE GREECE & THE ILIAD



Sail away with us into Greece’s legendary past. Explore the Acropolis, archaeological museums, and Bronze-Age sites in Crete, the Peloponnese, and Santorini. The itinerary has leisure time built into it for traveling scholars to wander on their own, to work on projects, and to relax.

Students also will learn the basics of sailing and sail for approximately 3-6 hours per day, for eight days on two yachts, to small villages built against sheer cliffs along the rugged Peloponnese coastline. We are responsible for purchasing our own food supplies for the cruise. Lunches are onboard; breakfasts and dinners either can be onboard with shopping and cooking duties shared by those who wish, or dining out—the individual’s choice.

Coursework requires reading two texts before June 14th and “publishing” a booklet, due July 30th. Students should have a project in mind before departure. See the brochure on the website (address at right) for ideas.
